VISIT REPORT

Building 1

I inspected the sky bridge to check on insect activity and found a few remaining dead stink bugs. There was no new insect activity in the Insect Monitoring Traps (IMT). On the exterior, I checked the Bait Stations and the following stations displayed rodent activity:

Box 9: 10g consumed- 1 bait replaced

Next visit: Monitor IMTs. Monitor rodent bait stations and refresh bait, as needed. Continue to follow up on the reports of 3rd floor pantry beetles.

Building 2

The deli has a major infestation of fruit flies and requires regular attention to sanitation to improve. I discussed sanitation issues and needs with Juan in detail. The fruit flies will remain if there organic material is present to attract them. I retreated the drains. This problem will not improve until the kitchen staff cleans up breeding sites more regularly and thoroughly. No other insect activity to report.

Bait Stations:

Box #5 - 10g consumed-1 bait replaced.

Box #6 - 10g consumed-1 bait replaced

Next service: Monitor IMTs. Monitor rodent bait stations and refresh bait, as needed. Spot treat drains for fruit flies, if needed.

Building 3

On the interior, I received reports of 2 spiders; however, no major new interior insect or spider activity. On the exterior, I checked the mouse traps in the parking garage and found no activity. No activity on exterior bait stations and no need to replace any baits at this visit.

Next service: Monitor IMTs. Monitor garage snap traps and rodent bait stations and refresh bait, as needed.

Building 6

The over all lady bug activity has majorly died down and I found only a few more dead lady bugs remaining in this building. Light trap and insect monitoring traps had little to no new activity.

Next service: Monitor IMTs and light trap.

Building 7

After being briefed on the rodent activity on the west side of the building, I located and communicated with Juan about the entry point through exterior conduit. The drain fly issue in the bathroom has subsided, but now there is a small number of fruit flies. I retreated the drains. In the riser room there are a lot of dead drain flies. Juan plans to clean them up. IMTs upstairs had no major issues.

Next service: follow up with Juan on rodent activity, monitor IMTs, and retreat for flies, if needed.

Building 8

No new signs of interior mice or insects. Juan will work on adding a door sweep in the back. I was informed of the 2 small paper wasp nests on the roof. I dewebbed the area and treated with Essentria. IMTs had no major issues.

Next service: Monitor IMTs.

Building 9

No pest activity reported and no insect activity on the IMTs.

Next service: Monitor IMTs.

Building 10

Nothing caught in the rodent snap traps and nothing major caught in the IMTs.

Next service: Monitor rodent traps and IMTs.

Building 11

One singular fly and pill bug was caught in the IMTs, but there is no significant indication of insect infestation. Juan let me in to the electrical/storage room. Our trap had been removed so I placed a new one. Juan is going to work on sealing off the gap in the back door there.

Next service: Monitor IMTs and light trap.

Trading Center:

No new insect activity on the interior found on the IMTs.

Bait Station:

Box #1 - 25g consumed 1 bait replaced

Box #3 - 80g consumed 4 baits replaced

Box #4 - 80g consumed 4 baits replaced

Box #6 - 80g consumed 4 baits replaced

Box #8 - 20g consumed 1 bait replaced

Box #9 - 15g consumed 1 bait replaced

Box #10 - 22g consumed 1 bait replaced

Next service: Monitor IMTs. Monitor rodent bait stations and refresh bait, as needed.
