VISIT REPORT

Building 1

I did an exterior perimeter application of Temprid FX as part of our quarterly prevention for insects. We had no reported issues on the interior since the last visit. All of the interior insect monitoring traps were free of new catches including the 3rd floor one where the beetles were reported previously.

Box 2: 20g replaced

Next visit: Monitor IMTs. Monitor rodent bait stations and refresh bait, as needed. Deweb the exterior with an additional technician, Fredy Barrios.

Building 2

I did an exterior perimeter application of Temprid FX as part of our quarterly prevention for insects. Fruit flies continue to be a problem in the deli. I treated the drains with Hot Spot. No other reported issues here. I monitored the insect traps and there was no major activity indicated.

The exterior bait boxes still have plenty of bait. No bait replaced today.

Next visit: Monitor IMTs. Monitor rodent bait stations and refresh bait, as needed. Deweb the exterior with an additional technician, Fredy Barrios.

I did an exterior perimeter application of Temprid FX as part of our quarterly prevention for insects. Deli is under a complete remodel. The light trap and insect monitoring traps have been removed temporarily. I will replace the IMTs once construction is completed. I checked all the mouse monitoring traps. No evidence of any issues today.

Bait Box #6 - 80g replaced

Next visit: Replace IMTs, if remodel is complete. Monitor rodent bait stations and refresh bait, as needed. Deweb the exterior with an additional technician, Fredy Barrios.

Building 6

Juan moved departments and Gary was on vacation so Anna was my point of contact today. Anna didn't have any info on the mason bees we previously treated for. I looked around and couldn't find any evidence of activity. Mason bees are only active for 8-10 weeks, so it is likely that they have run their course. The light trap and the insect monitoring traps showed no signs of any issues.

Next service: Monitor IMTs and light trap.

Building 7

There were reports of a few dead stink bugs around an emergency exit near the Build and Deploy lab. I spot treated the baseboards/window seals in the area with TempridFX.

I checked the insect monitoring traps and the mouse monitoring traps. No signs of new issues. No more issues reported with drain flies and no signs of the mouse.

Next service: Monitor IMTs and mouse traps. Follow up to see if stink bug issues persist.

Building 8

No new signs of interior mice or insects.

Next service: Monitor IMTs.

Building 9
